## PLEASE SELECT CATEGORY: AGE 10-12 YRS OLD \* You can only participate in one category

#### Be a Buddy, Not a Bully

Identify ways that people can stand up to bullying, safely. This project should display ways in which people can provide support to others who may be experiencing bullying. How can you make a difference by being an "Upstander"? Identify a target population, or choose to address the wider community.

**Bullyproof Your School** 

Create an initiative, program, or strategy to help to target the issue of bullying in your school. This project should answer the question: How can you help to ensure that your school is committed to being anti-bullying?

**The Bully Impact** 

Present the various impacts of bullying. This project should educate your audience on the impact that bullying has on the victim, the bully, and any other persons who may be affected.

#### **Don't Be Mean Behind the Screen**

Present a project on cyberbullying. What is cyberbullying and what are the effects? How can people protect themselves online or on social media and what should you do if you or someone you know is being cyberbullied?

Create an initiative, program, or strategy to help to target the issue of bullying in your school. This project should answer the question: How can you help to ensure that your school is committed to being anti-bullying?

October 1 <sup>st</sup> – October 3 <sup>rd</sup> :	Interscholastic Stood Up Competition	Registered students display their projects at their individual schools. Winners of each school are judged and selected by their school admin to represent their school at the Fair.
October 5 <sup>th</sup> :	Stood Up Day!	School Dress down day. Students and teachers elect to wear their purchased pink 'stood up' t-shirts to school in support of Anti-Bullying.
October 6 <sup>th</sup> :	Stood Up Interscholastic Anti- Bullying Fair	The selected winners from each school come together to display their projects at the community-based fair and will be judged by an FRC-selected panel. An overall winner will be selected from each age category. Students will receive individual prizes and their represented school will receive a trophy.
